Dr Purshotam Lal, who is also known as <u>"Father of Interventional Cardiology in India"</u> has been pioneer in introducing the largest number of Innovations in interventional cardiology as an alternative to open-heart surgery in India. For his unwavering commitment and contribution in the field of healthcare, Dr Lal was bestowed with the prestigious <u>Padma Bhushan in 2003</u>, the <u>Padma Vibhushan in 2009</u>, and was honoured with the prestigious <u>Dr BC Roy National Award</u> by the President of India for developing interventional cardiology in the country. In his field of expertise, Dr Lal has been recognised with numerous awards including <u>Distinguished Achievement Award of the Highest Order</u> by the National Forum of Indian Medical Association (2006–2007) for performing the largest number of Angioplasties/Stentings in the country as a single operator. He was also bestowed with <u>Lifetime Achievement Award</u> by the Times of India and Delhi Medical Association. His achievements have been listed in Limca Book of World Records on multiple occasions.

Dr Lal is internationally trained & experienced interventional cardiologist with fellowships from American College of Cardiology; American College of Medicine; Royal College of Physicians (Canada); Indian College of Cardiology & Society for Cardiac Angiography & Interventions (USA).

20 FIRST'S OF CARDIOLOGY BY DR. (PROF.) PURSHOTAM LAL:

Dr. Lal has the unique distinction of introducing largest number of procedures in the field of Interventional Cardiology for the first time in the country & world. Also, His papers were 1st to get published both, nationally & internationally.

World's Firsts:

- 1992: World's 1st case of non-surgical closure of hole ASD using monodisk (a device of nylon mesh)
- 2004: World's 1st TAVI (Transcatheter Aortic Valve Implantation) with Core Valve (without surgery)
- 2016: World's 1st Hybrid Case of Venibri TAVI + PTCA of main artery

Asia's Firsts:

- 1990: Asia's 1st case of Non-surgical PDA Closure with modified technique
- 2016: Asia's 1st case of Venibri TAVI

India's Firsts:

- 1989: India's 1st case of Slow Rotational Angioplasty in India
- 1990: India's 1st case of Coronary Athrectomy (shaving off fatty tissues)
- 1990: India's 1st case of Endomyocardial Biopsy with ECHO-Guidance
- 1990: India's 1st case of Transjugular Intrahepatic Portosystemic Shunt (TIPS)
- 1990: India's 1st case of High Risk Angioplasty supported by Cardiopulmonary Bypass
- 1991: India's 1st case of Coronary Implant as bail-out device
- 1991: India's 1st case of Non-surgical Left Atrio Femoral Bypass Support
- 1992: India's 1st case of ARTHREO-ABRASION where Rotablator (also known as Diamond Drilling) was used
- 1992: India's 1st case of PTMC (Inoue Balloon Mitral Valvuloplasty)
- 1992: India's 1st case of PDA by Russian Technique
- 1996: India's 1st case of Pullback Athrectomy
- 1997: Performed 1st of its kind procedure Multiple Heart Hole Closure, for patient having both ASD & VSD
- 1997: Implanted a Gold stent in a patient with high incidents of blood clot
- 1998: India's 1st case of Angiogenesis
- 1998: India's 1st case of Non-surgical repairing of aneurysms of abdominal aorta & lilac arteries
- 1998: India's 1st case of Acolysis
- 1998: Introduced Intravascular Red Laser Light Therapy (post Angioplasty)
- 1998: Introduced a quick heart test Metro Coronary Screening, a 3 minutes test as an alternative to angiography
- 1998: Introduced Percutaneous Transmyocardial Revascularization to create micro holes in myocardium
- 2001: India's 1st case of heart hole (VSD closure) without surgery in a patient with heart attack
- 2011: Introduced Intra Coronary Hydrolysis to take the clot out
- 2005: Introduced local drug delivery catheter Genie as cheaper option for stents
